The Center for Professional Development promotes advanced development for the dental professional in a two-day intensive while raising funds for the foundation through tuitions, fees and training programs exclusively offered by the Center.

"It is our hope to promote the foundation as a significant community resource. Not only in our effort to give back but to help raise the level of involvement we all have in the day-to-day struggle of our fellow man," says Dr. Stephen Boger, Foundation Chairman and Clinical Director of Boger Dental. "This foundation is the vehicle we have developed to insure our future commitment to making Minnesota and the world a healthier, happier place. It's the same philosophy that drives our dental practice," said Dr. Boger. "Viewing people not as just teeth to repair but as whole people with lives and wants and needs and desires. They all want to be considered and we do."
